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Information of Workshops and Roundtable Discussions

Workshops: Each facilitator shares their presentation for 15 minutes, followed by 15 minutes of discussion.

Roundtable Discussions: Roundtable discussions provide an interactive forum where participants will share the current issues in Chinese language teaching and discuss the new vision and new inspiration for TCSL at all levels. After the panelist shares their thoughts on the theme of discussion in less than ten minutes, the audience will participate in an interactive discussion with each speaker taking turns and speaking for a maximum of 2 minutes.

Following a main roundtable discussion session, the participants will be directed into two breakout rooms (K-12 and post secondary) for more focused discussion.
